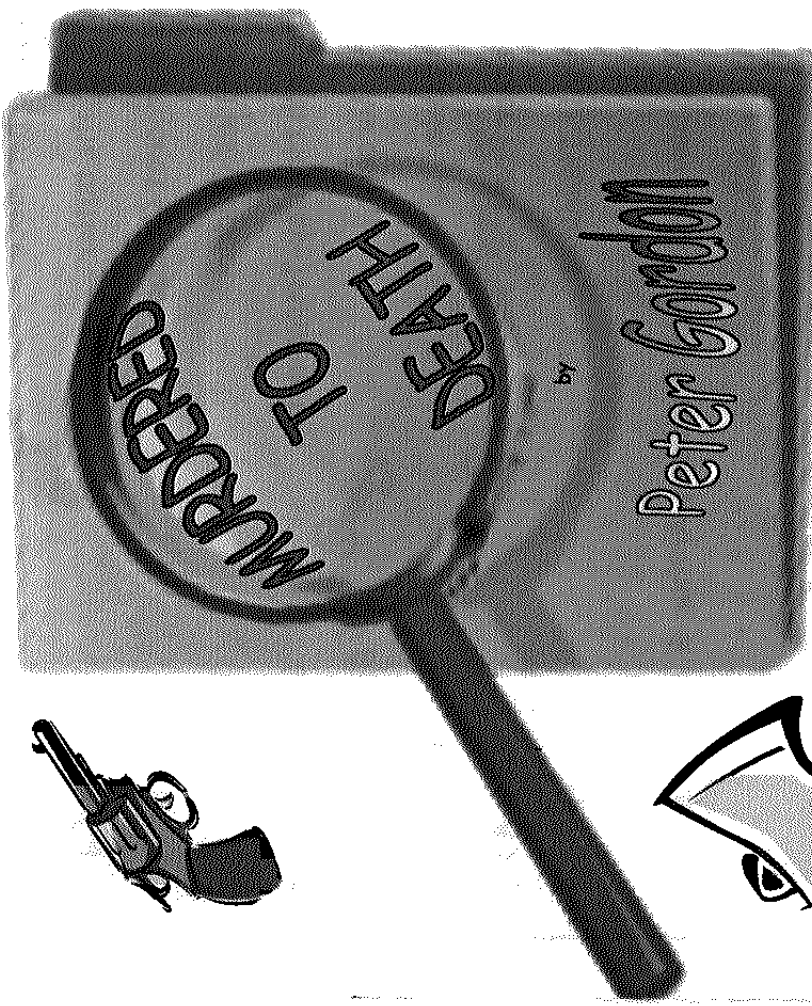
It just remains for me to welcome you all to our theatre, to thank you for your continued support and hope you will enjoy this evening and the rest of the season with us.

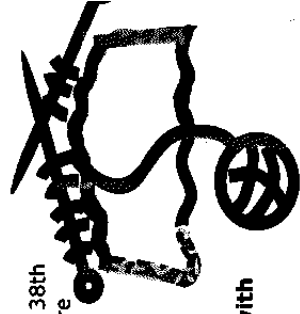
